{mosimage}As previously reported in Soapdom's Suds Buzz column, Emmy® and Tony® Award-winning actor Hal Linden ("Barney Miller") will join The Bold and the Beautiful for a limited run in the role of Jerry Kramer, a mysterious man from Jackie's (Lesley-Anne Down) past.
